A GARDEN GROVE FAMILY IN NEED

Many families with young children found it increasingly difficult to make ends meet over the past year due to under-employment in the wake of COVID-19 restrictions. In Garden Grove, the Bañuelos family faced challenging times raising their nine-year-old son and eight-year-old daughter without a consistent income.



Finances were already tight before the pandemic, given the cost of living in California. The parents had to budget carefully just to afford food. During the pandemic, Miguel, the breadwinner, began to lose hours from his job, which in turn affected the rest of the family. There were times when there was no work for him at all. The family had to find a way to get by. Sometimes hard choices had to be made when there was only enough money to either purchase groceries, pay rent, or pay bills.

Seeing their children go hungry took a toll on the parents. As the family struggled to retain independence and provide for themselves, they reluctantly decided they had reached the point where they needed to ask for help. The parents were determined to do whatever it took to put food on the table.

Thankfully, the Bañuelos family discovered Second Harvest which has helped them remain hopeful for their children's future, while relieving the stress of wondering how they would get enough money for groceries. Now the family knows their children will be able to get the nutrition they need on a daily basis. The Bañuelos family has expressed how grateful they are each day for Second Harvest, as well as for the donors who make everything possible.
