# WHAT IS HUNGER ACTION MONTH (HAM)?

September is Hunger Action Month – an annual nationwide campaign that unites Food Banks, antihunger organizations and the public to inspire people to take action against hunger and to raise awareness for those facing food and nutritional insecurity in our communities.

Activities take place throughout the month, with collective efforts focusing around Hunger Action Day on **Tuesday, September 9, 2025**.

## **GENERAL TALKING POINTS**

- Everyone needs nutritious food to thrive. Yet, tens of millions of people in the United States face hunger every day.
- •In Orange County: Over 359,000 individuals are food insecure, including over 86,000 children. (Source: Feeding America)
- •In the first half of 2025, Orange County's two food banks, Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County and Orange County Food Bank, together have collectively distributed 36,709,298 pounds of food through their networks of food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, senior centers, schools,

colleges, universities, houses of worship, and other community organizations throughout Orange County.

- •That's why this September, we are asking everyone to join in the movement to end food insecurity.
- •Your voice, action and commitment will help ensure every community has the food they need to thrive.
- •When people are fed, futures are nourished.
- •Throughout the month of September, Food Banks and the community can come together to support our neighbors in need.

## **TOP 5 WAYS TO TAKE ACTION**
