What is Grocery Rescue?

The Grocery Rescue Program helps grocery stores donate safe, surplus food to community members experiencing food insecurity, rather than *sending it to landfills*. This initiative not only supports those in need but also protects our environment by reducing greenhouse gas emissions and promoting sustainability.

How It Works

Dedicated Support

A Second Harvest Food Bank **Grocery Rescue Coordinator** will be your main point of contact, offering training, feedback, and ongoing assistance throughout the program.

Simple Pickups

We'll arrange scheduled pickups using our fleet or a local member of our Community Partner, tailored to your store's volume and availability.

Pre-Launch Training

Before starting, we'll:

- Train your team on what is and isn't acceptable to donate
- Review best practices for donation preparation
- Introduce your Community Partner for a smooth handoff



SB 1383 Compliance

We'll provide the necessary **agreement** and **monthly reporting** to support your compliance with California's SB 1383 food recovery requirements.

Benefits of Donating Food

Reduces Food Waste: Donating food diverts it from landfills, reducing methane emissions and helping combat climate change.

Supports Local Communities: Provides nutritious food to those in need, improving health and well-being.

Economic Benefits: Saves disposal costs and may qualify for tax deductions.
