HOW DO I UNDERWRITE?

WHEN WILL I BE ABLE TO UNDERWRITE?

Underwriting launches on Tuesday, June 9th, 2026.

AM I GUARANTEED A SEAT IF I UNDERWRITE?

Priority will be given on a first come, first served basis and depending on underwriting level.

WILL I RECEIVE A REFUND IF I AM UNABLE TO ATTEND IN PERSON?

No, underwriting donations are an immediately processed direct donation to Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County

DO I NEED TO RSVP?

Your underwriting donation is not a RSVP.

Kindly submit your [RSVP here](#) by September 7, 2026. Please note that your RSVP form submission can be updated at any time. If you're not sure who your guest is yet, that's okay. If you'd like to note who else you might like to sit with at your luncheon table, please comment using the above form.

CAN I UNDERWRITE CLOSER TO THE EVENT, LIKE IN SEPTEMBER?

We are anticipating a sold-out event. It's recommended that you submit both your Underwriting and RSVP forms once underwriting launches in June 2026. However if you'd like to notify Harvesters that you will be underwriting, so that we may expect your check or credit card payment, please contact Alise Gottschalk at Alise@FeedOC.org.

WHEN WILL I KNOW THAT I AM GUARANTEED ATTENDANCE?

It depends on how soon you underwrite and RSVP. Priority will be given on a first come, first served basis and depending on underwriting level. If necessary, Harvesters will offer a waitlist and will notify you as soon as possible.

CAN I DONATE MY SEATS BACK? I WANT TO UNDERWRITE BUT DO NOT PLAN TO ATTEND.

Yes, we hope you will attend. But if you are unable to, we would appreciate if you would consider donating your seats back to Harvesters, so we can continue to raise critical funds for Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County.

CAN I PURCHASE AN INDIVIDUAL TICKET TO THE EVENT?

Harvesters does not sell individual tickets to the Fashion Show & Luncheon. We kindly suggest that if you'd like to attend, please consider underwriting. 100% of your underwriting donation goes directly to Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County.

HOW WILL I RECEIVE UPDATES REGARDING THE EVENT?

HOW MANY GUESTS CAN SIT AT A TABLE?

Table seating will accommodate at least 8, and as many as 10-12, at some tables. We look forward to seating you with your guests and friends.

WILL THERE BE A SILENT AUCTION?

Yes, this year's silent auction will be 100% mobile and launch a week prior to the October 7 event. There will be a select group of items including South Coast Plaza luxury retailers,

travel and experiences, and the Opportunity Raffle prizes presented during the Champagne Reception hosted by Tiffany & Co.

HOW DO YOU PLAN TO DELIVER THE SILENT AUCTION GIFTS IF IT'S ALL MOBILE?

We plan to deliver the silent auction items to the luncheon tables of the winning guests attending the event. We will also have a table outside of the event, near valet parking, to collect your winning items as you leave. All silent auction winners who aren't attending the event will be contacted shortly after the event to arrange pick up from Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County.

IF I CAN'T ATTEND THE EVENT, CAN I STILL BID ONLINE?

Yes. After you confirm your underwriting donation, you will receive an invitation to set up a silent auction mobile bidding account a few weeks prior to the event. You can also participate in Harvesters silent auction without underwriting. Please reach out to Harvesters@FeedOC.org.

Harvesters 34th Annual Fashion Show & Luncheon takes place at 10:00am at Segerstrom Center for the Arts, 600 Town Center Drive, Costa Mesa, CA 92626. Once you've arrived at Valet, walk over to the entrance of the Renée & Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall, where you'll be greeted by Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County team members.

Kindly check-in at the registration tables to receive your Fashion Show & Luncheon seating and Silent Auction personal bidding link. If you haven't registered for our Silent Auction, event support team members will be present to support you. Our Silent Auction and Opportunity Raffle is entirely mobile, cash is not accepted.

After checking-in, head inside of the Concert Hall for photos and then go upstairs to the Tiffany & Co Champagne Reception to enjoy beverages, lite bites, and browse the silent auction and opportunity raffle items.

At 11:30 a.m., the Fashion Show presented by South Coast Plaza will take place at UC Irvine Langson Orange County Museum of Art. Immediately following the Fashion Show, all guests will walk to the Concert Hall Lobby for a three-course gourmet lunch served with wine.
